Rockcliffe CE School Sports Premium 2016 – 2017

Rockcliffe CE School has received £8475 for Sports Premium Funding for the year. This is being spent in the following way.

- To increase the amount of physical activity offered each day. The school has employed a Midday Sports Leader who ensures that sporting activities are offered on the MUGA each day. These are different sports and each child from Year 2 upwards is able to access an extra 30 minutes of physical activity per day. Cost £3074
- 2. To ensure that all child from Year 3 meet the national minimum standard for swimming. In addition to the usual spend on swimming we have offered swimming all year to children form Year 1 to Year 5. Those children who cannot swim to the required standard in KS2 have also had a further term of swimming to help them meet the standard.

Cost £480 per term (Two additional terms is £960)

3. PE Coaching. We have continued to buy in a Sports Coach for all classes for one hour per week. Staff are also using this as ongoing CPD as they learn how to teach a variety of sports. Trinity School also provide Spiorts Coaching for a Class each week as part of the Swimming contract.

Cost £3740

- Skiing. Children in Year Six were given the chance to develop skills in a new area, in this case skiing. This saw them travel to Edinburgh for a full days tuition. Cost £750
- 5. Gymnastics Coaching. Further support has been sought to develop coaching by buying in further support.

Cost £250

6. Equipment. A small amount of money has been used to buy equipment to support quality PE.

Cost £250

Total Spend for 2016/2017 is expected to be £9024 excluding transport cost for swimming and one terms swimming cost. These costs and the balance of £549 will be met from the schools delegated budget.
